

The goal of this project is to create a sandboxed demo account for potential instructors to test a “working” account populated with FilmSkills lessons, dummy student and instructor accounts, pre-built classes, courses, projects, tests, and certifications.

Enrolling

I will create a form on the FilmSkills WP site for people to apply for a demo account. I would need an interface in the siteadmin to create a username and password for each user. There is no need for a front-end automated solution as I want to control who can access this demo account.

Auto-account disable

I need to be able to set the number of days the account will remain active, probably 7 days. When the account closes, if the user attempts to log in, we will direct him to a marketing page on the WP site.

When an account closes, we should delete all content/media and sandbox accounts the user uploaded/created.

Master Log-In

I will need to be able to log into this demo account so I can create, edit, and update fake instructors, classes, courses, and certifications.

Sandbox

When the potential customer logs in, he will see a fully-branded, built-out account with existing classes, courses, certifications, etc. He can edit and change them, create new ones, create lessons, create instructor accounts, etc. Basically add, edit, or delete nearly anything in the account as if it were his own, EXCEPT:

- Regarding FilmSkills Lessons, disable:
 - Ability to edit or delete lessons
 - Ability to Network share lessons
 - Download any files

In general, we must disable the user from:

- Upload a video or PPT in Create a Lesson
- Upload images, slideshows into a lesson
- Downloading any existing files from any lesson, class, course, or project
- Network sharing anything to another account

- Editing any existing lesson
- Change the direct URL/URL mapping options
- Connect a Stripe or PayPal account
- If he creates a sample instructor, student, or affiliate account, those accounts will not be real accounts. They will all be sandbox accounts that cannot be used to log in with.
- If user batch creates student accounts, the notification e-mails will not be sent out
- Disable all e-mail notifications sent out from the system
- Send a support ticket (he can create one though)
- Transferring help tickets to another user
- Upgrade or cancel the AccuSkills subscription
- If the user goes to the direct URL and tries to join as a student, disable the CC process so he can log in to experience the site as a student.

Also, there are some areas of the site that I will need to populate fields that the demo user cannot change, including:

- Certificates (we don't want the user to create and print/save a certificate)
 - Institution Name
 - Name of Certification Program
 - Signature
 - Institute seal

If possible, we can allow them to login-as a student to see a student account, also with populated data.

The user should be able to watch the lessons, take tests, etc. However they cannot download any content or upload any project files.
