Update on Progress – Education for All Coalition

“Reflecting Progress and Charting the Future”

In 2018, the Education for All Coalition (EFAC) ([Education For All Coalition](#)) was asked to contribute to the development of the Global Compact on Refugees. In 2019, EFAC was invited to participate as an NGO member delegation to the Global Refugee Forum to present a pledge towards addressing education needs for refugee children. EFAC was also asked in 2019 to present a research paper “Making Education a Human Right for All: Progress, but Important Gaps Remain” to the Global Academic Interdisciplinary Network (G.A.I.N.).

Prior to the COVID 19 pandemic, EFAC conducted in-person international missions at refugee camps and settlements in countries abroad and served to improve the lives of refugee children with education resources, books, programs, activities and wellness kits. Due to travel restrictions imposed by the pandemic from 2019 - 2021, engagement resorted to program development and online webinars and programs. EFAC anticipates hybrid in-country programs in 2022.

The coalition of EFAC is a systems-based team that responds to the education needs of displaced children forced to flee from their homes. EFAC in coordination with the Innovation Academy ([Innovation Academy – Premier Virtual Courses on Demand](#)) and Resilience, Inc. ([My Learning Tools](#)) addresses the needs of children through specialized learning ecosystems based on equitable access to education opportunities for all children. All programs are conducted with inclusion, diversity, assessment, and measurement in mind to ensure sustainability and success.

Program Core Pillars

- Education Resources & Services: addresses Early Childhood Development, Curriculum Development, Teacher Resources, Teacher Development and Training, English Language Development, and Youth Mentorship;
- Social Emotional Learning Programs: addresses Well Being, Stress and Trauma Management.
- Digital Education Services: provides On-Line Learning, Virtual Programs, Safe Record Management and Certificates or Credentials indicating achievements which are applied towards school placement and career opportunities; and
- Climate Literacy addresses Education and Community Garden activities.
