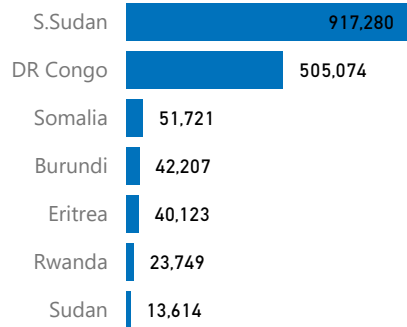

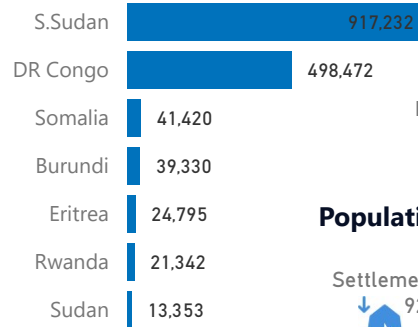

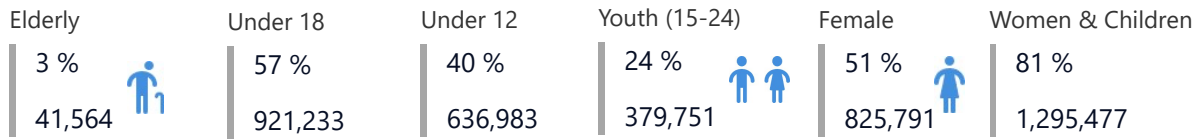
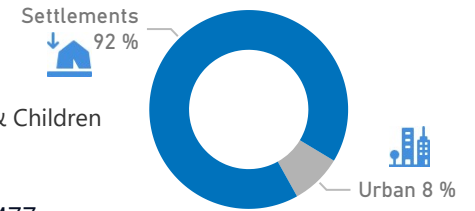
Top 7 Refugee Population



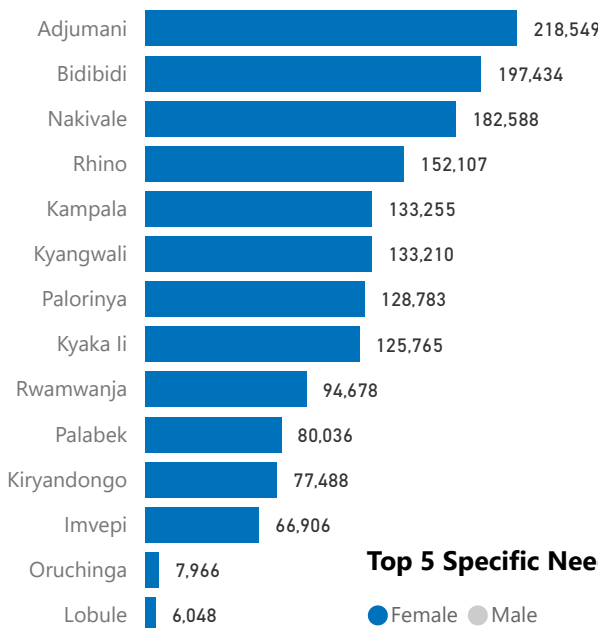
Top 4 Asy. Seeker Population



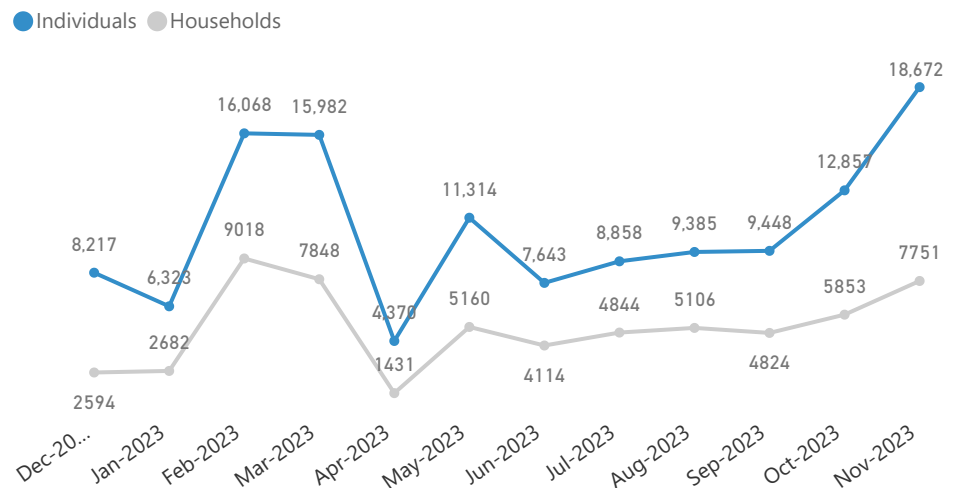
Population Distribution



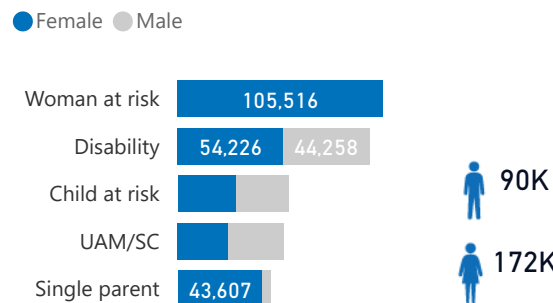
Population by settlement



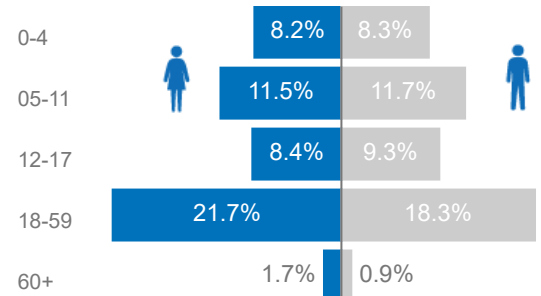
New arrival registration over the last 12 months

Age & Gender Breakdown



Since the start of 2023, more than 152,400 individuals (including 31,480 new births) have been registered in Uganda, 32% of whom are new arrivals from South Sudan and 14% from the DR Congo. There was an increase of 21,804 individuals (1.3%) in the population from last month, resulting mainly from new arrival and continuous registration activities. Notably, the number of registered Sudanese increased since the start of the Sudan conflict in April, averaging more than 1,800 per month over the last three months.

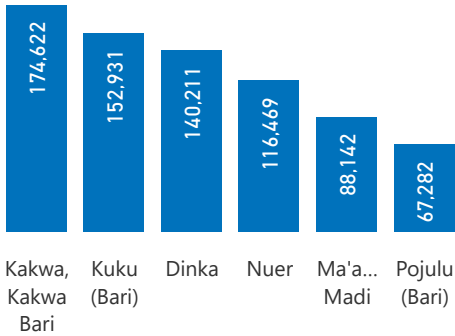

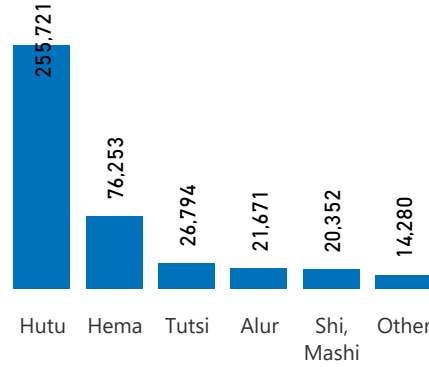

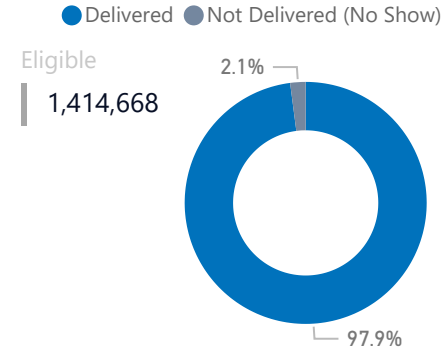
Top 6 South Sudanese Ethnicities



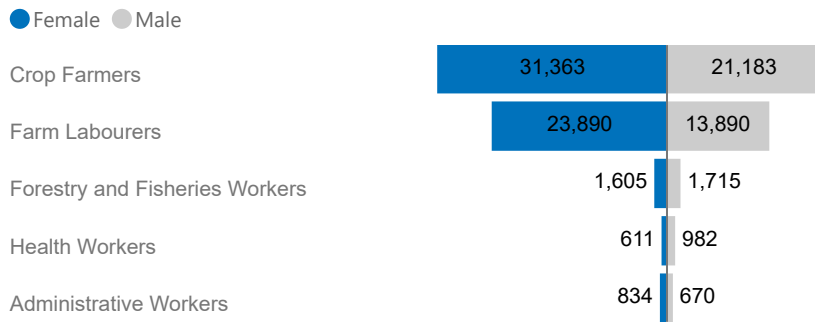
Top 6 Congolese Ethnicities



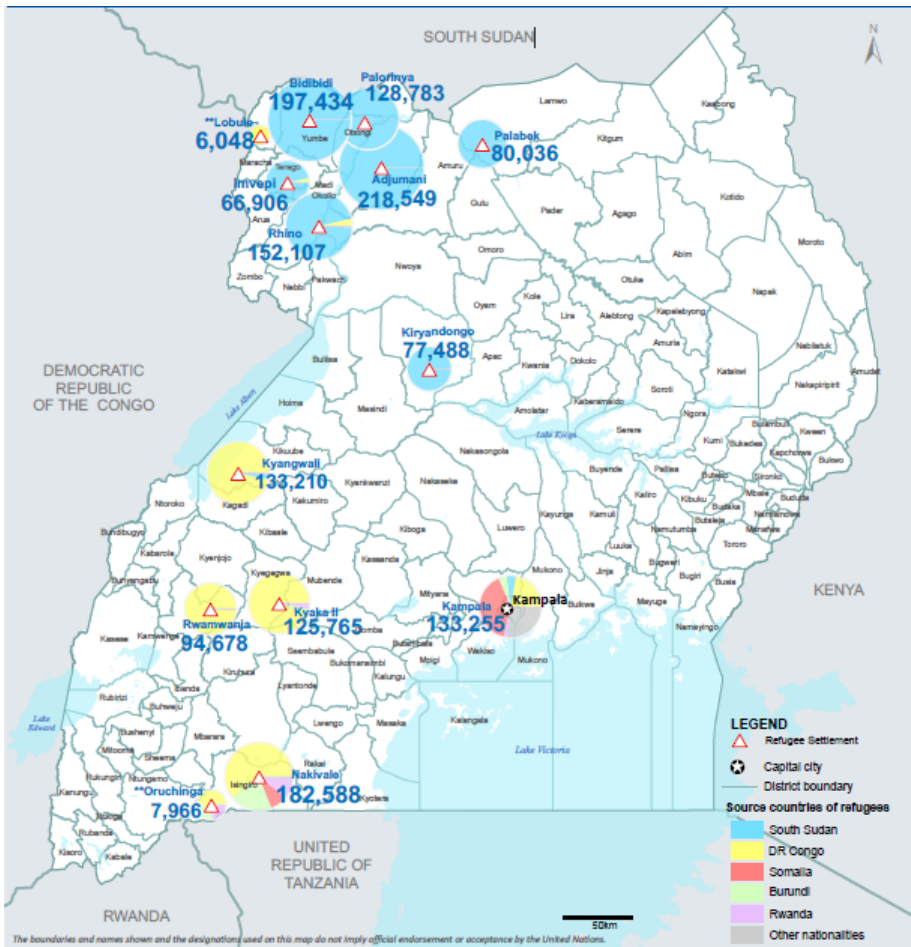
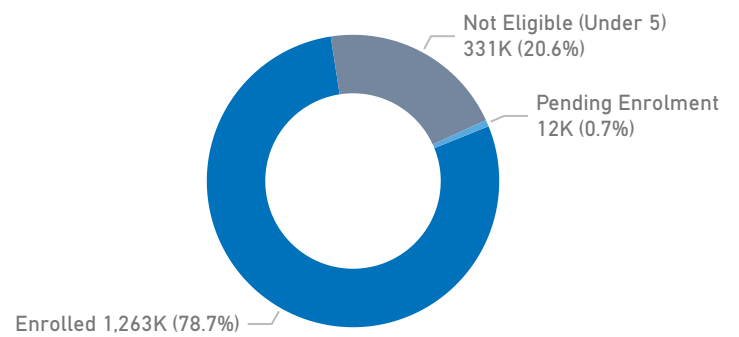
