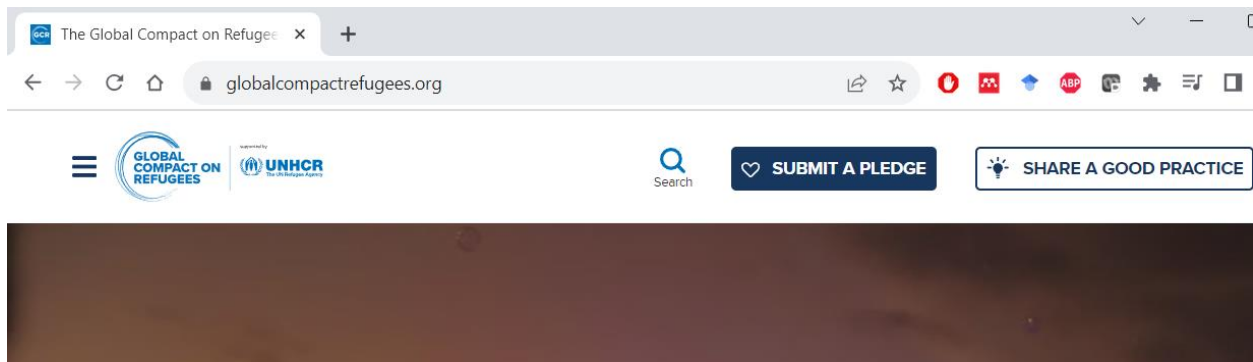


Step by Step Instructions on How to Update a Pledge

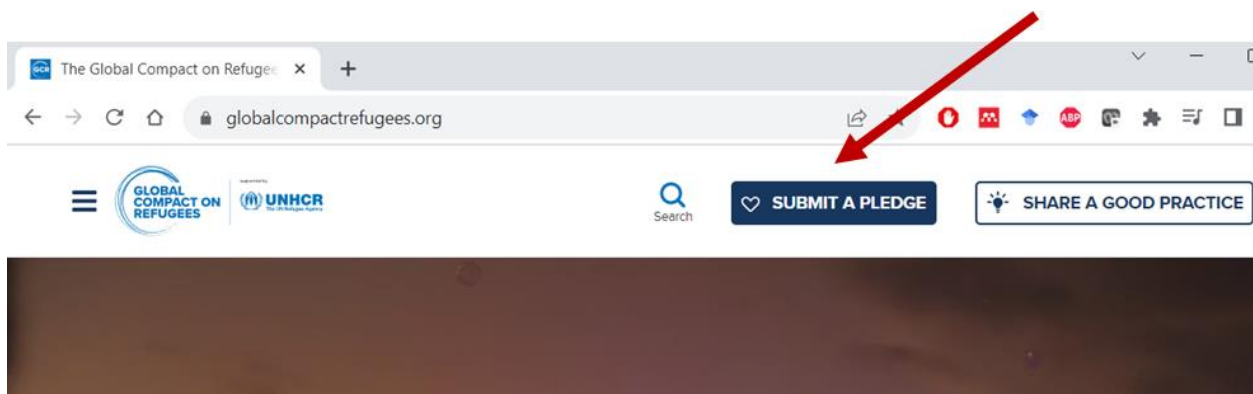

This is a step-by-step guidance note on how to submit a pledge update through the new pledge submission form.

First, you will need to access the Global Compact on Refugees Digital Platform, at <https://globalcompactrefugees.org/>.

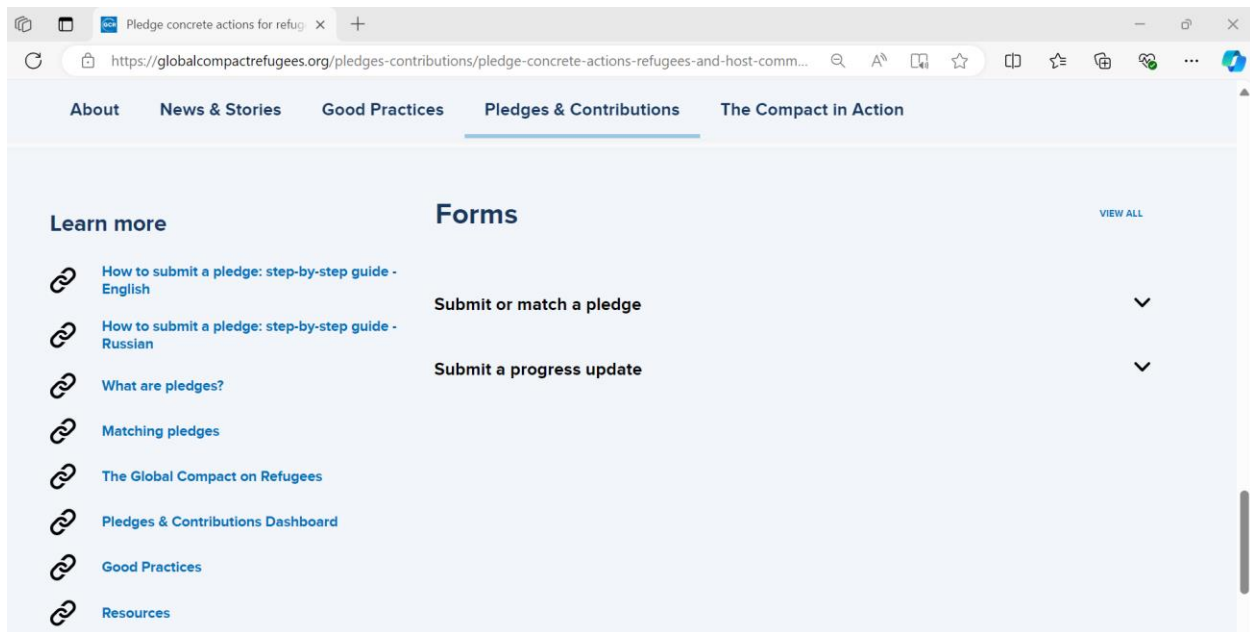


At the top of the page, click on the "Submit a pledge" button.



This will take you to the dedicated pledge submission and pledge update webpage with the title "Pledge concrete actions for refugees and host communities".

Please scroll down to the "Forms" section on this page.



This section consists of two subsections. The first subsection contains the "submit or match a pledge" form. The second subsection is for submitting a pledge progress update.

When you click on "submit a progress update," you will open the pledge update form.

Pledge follow-up EN v.3 PART 1

Pledge update instructions

States and other stakeholders are requested to use this template to provide updates on their progress towards implementing their pledges towards the implementation of the GCR objectives. This online system remains continuously open, and pledging entities are encouraged to submit updates on progress throughout the year, particularly when the status of their pledge implementation changes. Twice per year, UNHCR will publicize broad trends on the implementation of pledges based upon the updates received.

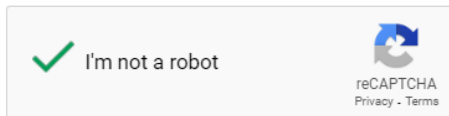
